Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is designed to create a positive and respectful learning environment for all students at CREOL's Summer Camp. Campers are expected to read this code of conduct and to adhere to the principles below, promoting a safe and inclusive community that fosters academic excellence, personal growth, and mutual respect.

1. Students shall treat all members of the camp with respect and kindness. This includes peers, teachers, staff, and visitors. Bullying, harassment, discrimination, and disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
2. Students are expected to refrain from using profane language as a part of our conduct standards.
3. Clothing that promotes violence, drugs, or offensive language is not permitted.
4. Students should use technology responsibly. This includes appropriate use of electronic devices, social media, and online platforms. Cyberbullying and unauthorized use of technology are strictly prohibited.
5. Students are expected to actively engage in the learning experience by attentively listening to instructors. Demonstrating a commitment to understanding and following instructions ensures a more enriching and productive educational environment for everyone.
6. Name badge must be worn properly at all times, as required.
7. Students are responsible for their own actions and their impact on others around. This includes taking care of lab property, cleaning up after oneself, and contributing positively to the overall camp environment.
8. Students must never be alone outside of the classroom. Unless given permission otherwise, all students must stay with their assigned buildings/rooms and be supervised by their instructors, teaching assistants, resident assistants, or a member of the CREOL Laser & Photonics Summer Camp staff.
9. Use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal substances will not be tolerated. Any items found will be confiscated and the student will be sent home.
10. Students should prioritize their safety and the safety of others. Any behavior that jeopardizes the well-being of oneself or others, including the possession of weapons, is strictly prohibited.
11. Violations of this code of conduct may result in expulsion from the camp.
